

Crew Responsibilities and Limitations

- ❖ You must provide a crew manifest and visitors list

Crew is defined as: Individuals who work on board when the owner is on board and named on ships insurance policy. All others are considered contractors and will need the appropriate insurance and credentials.

- ❖ This is a working shipyard adjacent to a second shipyard. Dirt, dust and overspray are abundant. Protect your owners investment by doing the following:
- ❖ Power lines, water lines, and mooring lines must be secured properly to not cause any tripping hazards or unsafe conditions.
- ❖ You may drive your boat when we need it moved.
- ❖ We encourage laying your own protective material.
- ❖ Perform your own cleaning and detailing while work is underway.
- ❖ Wash your waterline, if it can be reached from the pavement.
- ❖ Maintain the interior of your vessel while work is underway.
- ❖ Make sure your vessel is secured at night.

Limitations:

- ❖ No working on scaffolding.
- ❖ No working below the rub rail.
- ❖ No painting of any kind without prior authorization from RYC.
- ❖ No bottom work.
- ❖ No changing zincs.
- ❖ No working aloft on vessel without OSHA approved harness.
- ❖ No outside contractors without prior approval.
